# Key Issues Discussed:

The following key issues were discussed:

- 1. The Investment Division of the Ministry of Finance is responsible for the corporate governance of state enterprises and the respective line Ministry is responsible for operational issue of the state emterprises.
- 2. The Auditor General identified the School Nutrition Programme for special audit based on the high allocation of resources and public outcry.
- 3. The definition of a State Enterprise is a company that the government owns 51% or more of the shares.
- 4. The oversight mechanisms used by the Investment Division to monitor State Enterprises.
- 5. The financial model developed by Pricewaterhousecoopers Limited to determine the price to produce meals.
- 6. The correlation between the use of local produce food and low consumption of meals.
- 7. The procurement of caterers follow the process of open tendering.
- 8. The issue of wastage was explained by officials of NSDSL and steps were implemented to reduce the level of wastage of meals.
- 9. The restructuring of the Strategic Plan and key performance indicators which is required to improve the objectives of (NSDSL).
- 10. The status of the implementation of the recommendations provided by the Auditor General's Department.
